In the law industry, we are routinely posed situations that require us to solve problems that contain a large number of varying and moving parts. Strategy, anticipatory action and critical thinking are necessary in playing that "chess game" that I wrote about a couple months ago. But when you are implementing your decision making process, the theory of "Nature vs. Nurture"

seems to provide the fundamental backdrop for the course of action. The decision making strategy of the players is only run through their own personalities. Thus, the personality of the person implementing the strategy plays a very important role. The terms "nature vs nurture" relate to the relative importance of an individual's inherited qualities as compared to an individual's personal experiences.

This concept has been the subject of countless studies on behavior, genetics, heritage, personality and how those considerations intersect within the person. In the 2000s, lawyers for violent offenders in some cases began to argue that an individual's genes, rather than their rational decisionmaking processes, can cause criminal activity. That would be a "nature" argument. The other side of the coin would be the same lawyers arguing that they are a product of their environment and that is why they committed the crime. That would be a "nurture" argument.

I believe we are products of both. We are the sum total of our experiences and we exist with some heritable traits that impact our actions. Nowhere is this intersection discussed better than in Malcolm Gladwell's book *Outliers*. In order to truly understand how an opponent is motivated, you should endeavor to obtain an understanding of both their nature and their nurture. So in the age old question, "Nature vs. Nurture,
